### H1N1 VACCINE:

Projected doses needed for each target group: These estimates are for individuals to receive one dose, and do not take into account the recommendation for children younger than 10 years of age to receive a second dose.

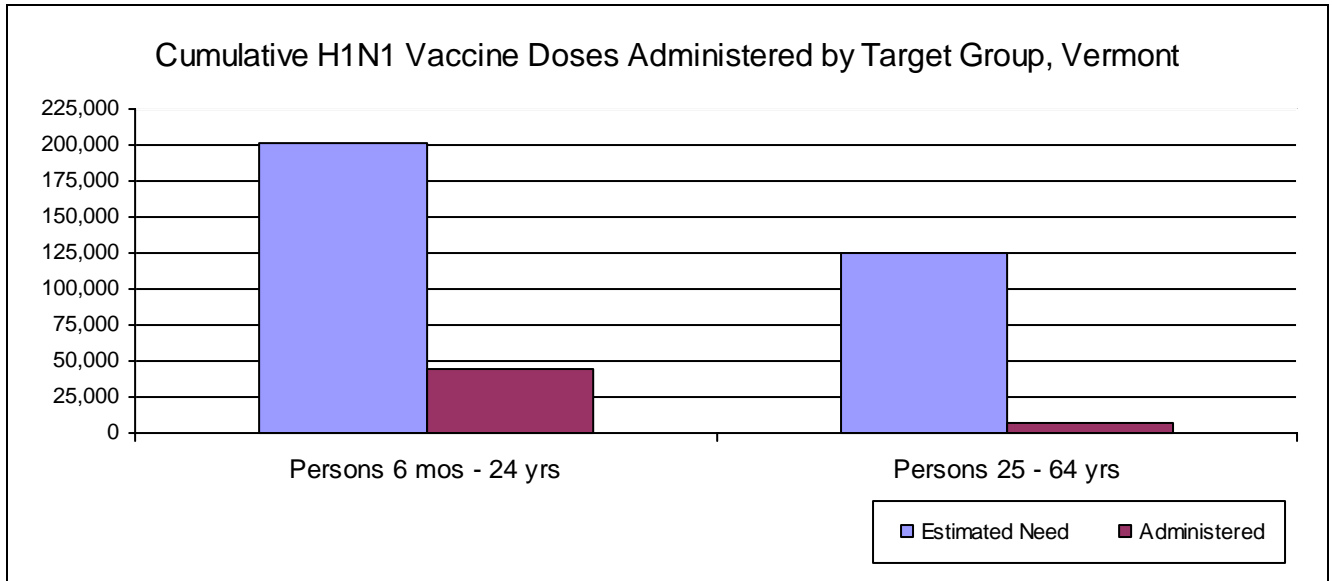
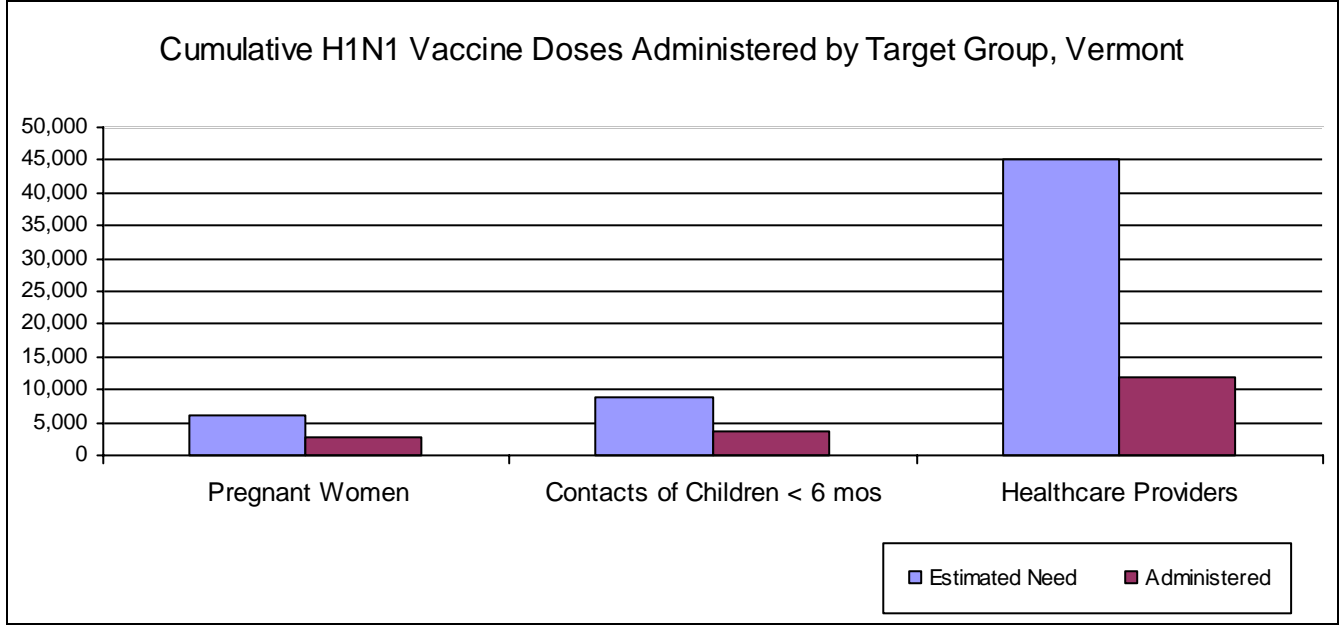

**PEDIATRIC SEASONAL INFLUENZA VACCINE:**

- The Vermont Department of Health provides seasonal influenza vaccine for children ages 6 months to 18 years through the Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program.
- VFC providers requested 47,000 doses of pediatric seasonal influenza vaccine this season.
- By November 25, 2009 Vermont will have ordered 40,280 doses.
- We anticipate receiving the rest of Vermont’s allocation in December 2009.
- We do not anticipate the availability of additional doses (beyond Vermont’s original request of 47,000 doses) this year due to unprecedented demand at the national level.
- The Vermont Department of Health does not provide season influenza vaccine for adults; that has traditionally been acquired through the private sector.
